Electronic Arts Have you ever wondered how YouTube Simmers gets your custom content — commonly called CC — in your Sims 4 game? Electronic Arts has never released an official tutorial on cc downloading in The Sims 4, and there are many YouTube tutorials, but they can be vague. Custom content, or Mods, are additional assets and behaviors created by other players for the purpose of enriching the game beyond the base game Maxis has published. This content often includes clothing for your Sims, features, aspirations, and more. Custom content is created and tested by users—it's a big part of the Sims community. In fact, Maxis encourages and supports the modding community! You can read more about this on the Sims 4 Mods and Game Updates FAQ page. So here's a detailed tutorial on how to activate and download mods in The Sims 4 on Windows 10. Set up custom content Find and open your feature.cfg File After launching Sims 4 and enabling mods in your game, find the Mods folder for Sims 4. The default path for your Sims 4 folder is located in the Documents folder. The Mods folder will be generated within the Sims 4 folder as soon as you have released the game with mods enabled. In the Mods folder, there is a Resource.cfg. Right-click to open it using a simple text editing program, such as Notepad. You should see something like this, but on a line: Priority 500 PackedFile *.package PackedFile */*.package PackedFile */*.package PackedFile */*.package This shows how many deep folders the system will check for mods/CC. The number of asterisks is equal to the number of deep folders. There should be six by default, as shown here. If you want to add more, just follow the same pattern. Create new folders in the Mods folder This is mainly for people who do not yet have folders within the Mods folder or have made folders, but there is nothing in them. If you already have some folders with things in them, but a lot of things that aren't, go ahead and move on. Create folders labeled Build/Buy and CAS. When you create folders to get started, you'll be better prepared to keep your files organized later. Enable mods in Your Game After launching the Sims 4 game, you will see a three-point icon in the upper right corner of the main menu. When you click on this, you will have the settings menu. Click the Others tab and select enable custom content and mods. That was the easy part. Go ahead and enable Script Allowed Mods, too. When the boxes are checked green, this means that the mods have been activated. Make sure the Mods folder is now in the EA folder When you downloaded your game, you chose a folder to install sims 4 for. Navigate to it and locate the Mods folder. You can usually find it in Documents > Electronic Arts > The Sims 4 > but you can have it installed elsewhere. We recommend using the built-in File Explorer search box to help you find find Folder. Choose a Mod and Download When clicking and downloading mods, it is very important to read the fine print. You will come across a huge selection of CC that is compatible with the base game (no packages required), however, many available mods will require a pack for one reason or another (such as a re-texture of a base game item). For the sake of this tutorial, I chose some mods compatible with basic games that are linked below. You will see that all these mod pages say compatible base game in the description: Note: The Women's Autumn Collection has separate files, so you can choose what you want to download. Packages sometimes come separately, but not always. Sometimes a set will be available only as a merged content pack. Here is a quick list of my favorite and trusted CC sites: Move the files to your Mods folder Locate the downloaded files on your computer and then move the files manually to the Sims 4 Mods folder. In the Mods folder, create a tutorial mods subpaspato (any name will suffice) and move all .package files from the downloads folder to the Tutorial Mods folder. CC that appears on the Create a Home screen (clothes, hair, accessories, etc.) will be stored in the CAS folder, Build/Buy CC should go in the Build Buy Mods folder, and so on. Keeping your folders organized can help you highlight corrupted files that cause problems in your game. Also, by putting newly downloaded mods in a separate folder, you can launch the game and decide whether or not you like the new mods you downloaded. We suggest that you store newly downloaded cc in a folder labeled as new mods for organizational purposes. If you start the game and decide you don't like what you downloaded, it's easy to navigate to the new folder and find out which file to delete. The screenshot above includes the file names of the downloaded content previously linked in this post for this how-to guide. Launch your game! Once you are on the Create a Home screen, click the Hair section. If you're having trouble finding the custom content you downloaded, click the small arrow next to Female, click content, and check the box next to Custom Content so that the hair section shows only custom content that you downloaded. You can enable this filter on all screens, even in Build/Buy! What is a Mod versus a Mod Script? Now that you've been a bit involved in custom content for The Sims 4, you might be wondering why we've connected script mods. Script mods are encoding mods that can change game behaviors as opposed to pre-existing Maxis encoding. A popular script mod is the user-created Sims 4 MC Command Center Mod, Deaderpool. The MC Command Center Mod has plenty of options in the form of multiple modules that address different features: adjusting household accounts, making selected sims immortal, pregnancies and even create mechanical story progression style. Pretty much anything you can think of, this mod can do and is updated on a continuous basis. We've talked about how to activate script mods, but where do you put the MC command center mod in the Mods folder? First, make sure that the modules and packages are placed in the same folder and that the folder is no more than a depth level in the Sims 4 mod folder structure. For example, The Sims 4\Mods\MCCC is fine, but The Sims 4\Mods\Script Mods\MCCC is not. The Sims 4 client only goes from one level to depth when searching for script mods. In the screenshot above, you will see that the McCmdCenter file is at the first level of the Mods folder. If you don't do this correctly, script mods won't appear in your game. Save and Back up your sims 4 folder As a general rule, always back up the Sims 4 folder to a USB drive or external drive in the event of a disaster. Right-click on your file and select Copy (Ctrl + C on keyboard), navigate to the safe place you made, and right-click and select Paste (Ctrl + V on keyboard) to the new location. This ensures that you have an updated copy of your game (Sims families and their mods) in case you have to reinstall the game. It takes time to build a collection, and it's a hassle to lose progress, as well as losing any saved data to any other video game. And that covers everything!
